



STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

July 21, 2016

On July 11, 2016, Bill Hammons, a Unity Party candidate for United States Senate, submitted 1482 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 8, 2016, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Hammons's petition must contain at least 1000 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

The Secretary of State has determined that Mr. Hammons submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures and will be placed on the 2016 general election ballot. A public record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office.

¹Section 1-4-802(1)(c)(II), C.R.S., requires signatures of eligible electors equal to "the lesser of four hundred or two percent of the votes cast in the house district in the most recent general election for the office of member of the state house of representatives."
